The five-year projection for the population in the area is 125,894 representing a change of 0.02% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 48.3% male and 51.7% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 78.8 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 47,581, a change of 0.36% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.61, compared to 2.65 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 31,731 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$72,513 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$79,099 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$98,587 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$110,867 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$36,955 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$42,242 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 66.8% of the 49,892 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.9%, renter occupied; and 6.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 48,589 housing units in the area and 6.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.82%. Median home value in the area is \$270,407, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.72% annually to \$294,470.

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
