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
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

#### Infographic: Key Facts (Drive Time: 10 minutes)



In the identified area, the current year population is 179,819. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 178,414. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.35% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 179,030 representing a change of -0.09% annually from 2022 to 2027. Currently, the population is 48.4% male and 51.6% female.

The median age in this area is 48.3, compared to U.S. median age of 38.9.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 13.1% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.0% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 58.8 in the identified area, compared to 71.6 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 63.6% of the 89,417 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.0%, renter occupied; and 10.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 88,766 housing units in the area and 10.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.33%. Median home value in the area is \$219,877, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.26% annually to \$284,108.
