  REMOVE PLUMBING FIXTURES AS ILLUSTRATED. REMOVE SANITARY PIPING AND/OR CONNECTION TO SLAB LEVEL AND PROPERLY CAP AND SEAL AS PER FBC 2010 PLUMBING ED. REMOVE SUPPLY LINES BACK TO MAIN TRUNK LINE OR TO BRANCH CONNECTION POINT IN PLENUM LEVEL
- 1 INTERIOR MILLWORK: REMOVE ALL EXISTING MILLWORK IN PREPARATION FOR NEW INTERIOR REMODEL
- 5 INTERIOR WINDOW: REMOVE ALL INTERIOR WINDOWS IN PREPARATION FOR NEW INTERIOR REMODEL
- EXISTING THERMOSTAT:
  REMOVE THE EXISTING THERMOSTAT (SAVE FOR REINSTALLATION) IN PREPARATION FOR NEW INTERIOR REMODEL
- 7 EXISTING ELECTRICAL FIXTURES AND RECEPTACLES REMOVE ALL RECEPTACLES WITHIN ANY WALL ILLUSTRATED TO BE DEMOLISHED. CHASE ALL WIRES BACK TO PANEL OR JUNCTION BOX FOR PROPER CAPPING. RECEPTACLES ALONG THE PERIMETER WALLS TO REMAIN SHALL REMAIN AS 15 ALSO. - FINISHED CEILING:
  EXISTING 2'X4' SUSPENDED CEILING GRID AND CEILING TILES THROUGH-OUT ENTIRE SPACE. REMOVE EXISTING CEILING TILES THRU-OUT IN PREP FOR NEW CEILING. (NOT ILLUSTRATED ON THE DEMOLITION PLAN)
- LIGHTING:
  EXISTING 2X4 FLUORESCENT LIGHTING FIXTURES THRU-OUT ENTIRE SPACE. CONTRACTOR TO REMOVE LIGHTS THRU-OUT IN PREP FOR NEW CEILING. (NOT ILLUSTRATED ON THE DEMOLITION PLAN)
- HYAC GRILLE:





DEMOLITION WORK SHALL NOT RESUME UNTIL WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED.
- 8. THE SCOPE OF DEMOLITION WORK UNDER THIS PERMIT IS LIMITED TO THE REMOVAL OF NON-STRUCTURAL BUILDING ELEMENTS WITHIN THE EXISTING SPACE, AS DEPICTED BY DASHED LINES. ELEMENTS TO BE REMOVED AND DISCARDED ARE DESCRIBED BELOW.
- 9. REMOVE ALL FINISHES IN ALL AREAS, STRIP AWAY ALL BACKING AND SUPPORT FOR FINISHES, EXPOSING STRUCTURE BENEATH IN ALL AREAS, ALL CONDITIONS THROUGHOUT.


