Currently, 68.6% of the 30,239 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 24.1%, renter occupied; and 7.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 30,025 housing units in the area - 71.4% owner occupied, 22.2% renter occupied, and 6.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.32%. Median home value in the area is \$214,839, compared to a median home value of \$177,257 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.27% annually to \$240,329.
