

RICHLOAM WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

This property is adjacent to the The Richloam Wildlife Management Area (WMA), part of the greater Withlacoochee State Forest.

The Richloam WMA is a significant conservation area located in Central Florida, primarily within Sumter, Hernando, Lake, and Pasco counties. Covering over 58,000 acres, this WMA is managed by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC). The area features a diverse mix of ecosystems, including pine flatwoods, hardwood hammocks, and cypress swamps, providing critical habitats for a wide variety of wildlife.

Richloam WMA offers numerous recreational opportunities such as hunting, fishing, hiking, birdwatching, and horseback riding. The area is also notable for its historical significance, with remnants of early 20th-century turpentine camps and old railroad grades. The management practices in Richloam focus on maintaining the natural habitats and supporting the native wildlife populations, making it a vital area for both conservation and outdoor activities.




