In the identified area, the current year population is 104,611. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 103,972. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.14% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 102,910 representing a change of -0.33% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 48.8% male and 51.2% female.

The median age in this area is 42.3, compared to U.S. median age of 39.3.

Persons of Hispanic origin represent 29.0% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 85.3 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The household count in this area has changed from 42,077 in 2020 to 43,039 in the current year, a change of 0.53% annually. The five-year projection of households is 43,385, a change of 0.16% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.40, compared to 2.44 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 24,499 in the specified area.

Data Note: Income is expressed in current dollars. Housing Affordability Index and Percent of Income for Mortgage calculations are only available for areas with 50 or more owner-occupied housing units. The Gini index measures the extent to which the distribution of income or consumption among individuals or households within an economy deviates from a perfectly equal distribution. A Gini index of 0 represents perfect equality, while an index of 100 implies perfect inequality.

Households by Income

Current median household income is \$56,803 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$64,280 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$89,559 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$101,659 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$37,117 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$43,148 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Socioeconomic Status Index

2024 Socioeconomic Status Index	36.1	35.0	39.2
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Currently, 35.8% of the 59,536 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 36.5%, renter occupied; and 27.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 58,867 housing units in the area and 28.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.27%. Median home value in the area is \$342,392, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.04% annually to \$417,313.

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
