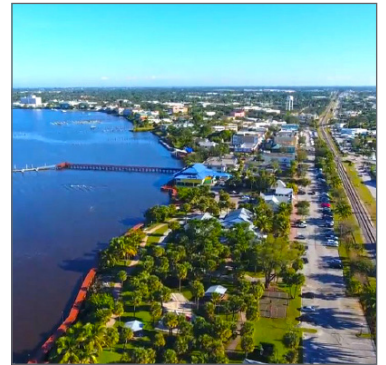
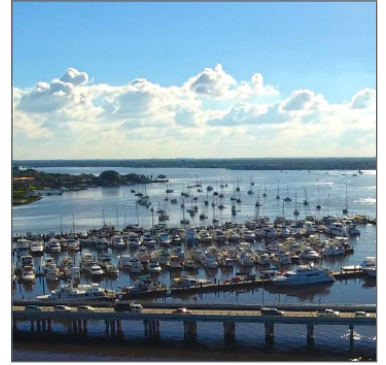
## Martin County, Florida
