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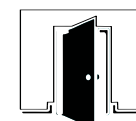

FROM SETTLEMENT TO CITY

Lake Mary, with roots dating back to the 19th century, officially incorporated as a city on August 7, 1973. Initially named after the wife of a minister who settled by the lake's northern shores, Lake Mary originally consisted of two small settlements known as Bent's Station and Belle Fontaine, situated along the Sanford-Orlando railroad line. Originally centered around citrus agriculture, Lake Mary began its transformation into a semi-rural bedroom community in the early 1970s, driven by the northward expansion of Disney developments. Subsequently, in the late 1980s and early 1990s, the city experienced rapid residential growth and economic development, evolving into a hub with significant office, retail, and industrial spaces.

Experience the allure of Lake Mary through its scenic Rinehart Trail, an integral part of the Cross Seminole Trail system, perfect for biking, running, walking, or roller blading. 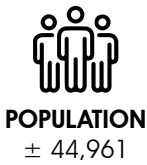

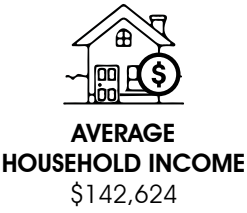
