Currently, $58.6 \%$ of the 79,287 housing units in the area are owner occupied; $19.7 \%$, renter occupied; and $21.7 \%$ are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., $55.7 \%$ of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; $32.8 \%$ are renter occupied; and $11.6 \%$ are vacant. In 2010, there were 76,397 housing units in the area - $61.0 \%$ owner occupied, $16.9 \%$ renter occupied, and $22.1 \%$ vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is $1.66 \%$. Median home value in the area is $\$ 127,293$, compared to a median home value of $\$ 200,006$ for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by $5.36 \%$ annually to $\$ 165,229$.
