Current average household income is \$53,908 in this area, compared to \$74,699 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$61,951 in five years, compared to \$84,910 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$25,256 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$28,597. The per capita income is projected to be \$29,224 in five years, compared to \$32,501 for all U.S. households

Currently, 64.5% of the 149,678 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 16.0%, renter occupied; and 19.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 135,116 housing units in the area - 66.8% owner occupied, 14.6% renter occupied, and 18.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.65%. Median home value in the area is \$173,944, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.94% annually to \$221,406.
