

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

This lake district recreational property is a pristine timberland ecosystem sitting in between the most coveted recreational outlets the state of Georgia has to offer. The University of Georgia and accompanying SEC athletics are but a short drive away in Athens and world-class golf can be found nearby at the renowned Reynolds at Lake Oconee complex. Exquisite bass fishing and lake sports can be found throughout the lake district and great hiking and camping can be accessed nearby in the ample national forests.

The subject property features gentle rolling hills covered with 260 \pm acres of pine plantation. The balance of the acreage consists of a variety of natural hardwood species. The habitat is perfectly balanced and the deer herd has been well managed for years. There is river frontage along the eastern boundary and there are multiple internal creek systems winding throughout the parcel. The property has significant road frontage along the southern boundary with multiple gated access points. The internal road system is well maintained and multiple food plots have been cleared. The plots are currently planted in clover.

The property has been managed intensively for timber and hunting and sits between other large, quality managed properties. The 11,400-acre B.F. Grant Wildlife Management Area owned by the University of Georgia sits just across the eastern boundary. The B.F. Grant has been intensively managed by QDMA standards in order to produce an excellent whitetail deer population and is known for producing a 215" non-typical in 1974 that was the largest deer killed in North America in that year. Research conducted by UGA biologists is often shared with the neighboring landowners in order to benefit the area as a whole and cooperative management strategies have made this area an incredible wildlife mecca.


