The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 84.5 in the identified area, compared to 65.4 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$42,936 in the area, compared to \$64,730 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$47,016 in five years, compared to \$72,932 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$66,211 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$73,916 in five years, compared to \$103,679 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$25,770 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$28,753 in five years, compared to \$39,378 for all U.S. households

Currently, 31.6% of the 46,143 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 39.2%, renter occupied; and 29.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 46,292 housing units in the area - 32.9% owner occupied, 37.8% renter occupied, and 29.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is -0.14%. Median home value in the area is \$234,671, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.77% annually to \$296,310.
