Current median household income is \$77,353 in the area, compared to \$64,730 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$84,610 in five years, compared to \$72,932 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$105,428 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$117,587 in five years, compared to \$103,679 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$41,043 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$45,730 in five years, compared to \$39,378 for all U.S. households

Currently, 46.5% of the 59,243 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 15.6%, renter occupied; and 37.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 57,769 housing units in the area - 47.8% owner occupied, 15.6% renter occupied, and 36.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.13%. Median home value in the area is \$291,996, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.52% annually to \$347,084.
